CHMOW delivers two fresh meals a day (a cold lunch and a hot supper), five days a week, 52 weeks a year. Our caring and committed volunteers deliver not only delicious meals but also special holiday treats donated by community schools and groups, thoughtful cards on birthdays, and the local newspaper every Wednesday. But most importantly, CHMOW volunteers provide clients and their loved ones (sometimes living miles away) with the reassurance of at least one daily and caring connection to the outside world, supporting the desire to continue to live independently.

Who We Serve: Residents of Chestnut Hill, Mt. Airy, Oreland, Wyndmoor, Flourtown, Erdenheim, parts of Germantown and Lafayette Hill, regardless of age, whose access to food sources is either temporarily or permanently limited due to age, illness or disability.

Chestnut Hill Meals on Wheels is a nonprofit, community based service organization providing affordable quality meals to our homebound neighbors. Any person living in Chestnut Hill, Erdenheim, Flourtown, Lafayette Hill, Oreland, Wyndmoor, Mt. Airy and parts of Germantown or surrounding neighborhood, who is challenged by the preparation of nutritious meals, is eligible to participate in our meal delivery program regardless of age or income.
